


Fig. 47. — Leptychaster Kerguelenensis, E. Smith. Off Cape Maclear, Kerguelen Island. Twice the natural size.

a handsome star-fish allied to *Luidia* or *Archaster*, which has since been described by Mr. Edgar Smith, from specimens brought home by the Rev. Mr. Eaton, under the name of *Lepty-chaster Kerguelenensis* (Fig. 47).
