Fig. A. *Bathygadus cottoides* (page 154).

Kermadec Islands, Station 169 ; depth, 700 fathoms. In the principal figure the majority of the scales are restored ; also a view of the outer branchial arch, twice the natural size, is given.

Fig. B. *Bathygadus multifilis* (page 155).

South of the Philippine Islands, Station 214 ; depth, 500 fathoms. The majority of the scales are restored.

Fig. C. *Lyconus pinnatus* (page 158).

South Atlantic. With a separate view of the mouth, enlarged.

Fig. D. *Onus carpenteri* (page 97).

Between Shetland and Faröe ; depth, 180 fathoms.
